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General Comments

1. Cover Page

- Title
- Name of author & student ID
- Date, Institute, University
- Type of document(Bachelor IK thesis)
- Number of ECs (size of the research)
- Supervisor name & email address
- Student signature
- Supervisor signature

2. Research Method

- Not only mentioning the research tool which you apply, but also explaining how actually this tool will be applied to steps of your research (*e.g. not only mentioning Scrum, but what you will do with it in your research*)

General Comments

3. Time plan

- Steps of research & plan for submission of results
- Testing & validation plan
- Leave time for writing of the report
- Plan preparing the final presentation
- Two main deadlines:
 - April 9 (signed thesis proposal) &**
 - June 20 (Final thesis submission**
 - Hard deadline June 22)**

4. Measurement & validation

- Not enough to only perform the research, but you must also plan how to measure the success or usefulness of your results, which clarifies the contribution of your thesis

General Comments

5. Potential risks and possible solutions

- Identify what can go wrong and constitute the risks for your research
- Suggest some possible solution approaches addressing each risk item

6. Writing of the report

- Be precise and justify what you state (either by reasoning about it, or giving a reference)
- Do not say things such as: "*over the years... something has happened*" - specify starting when and the duration, e.g. in recent decades,...
- Write formally, e.g. isn't, didn't, haven't, etc. are not good to use in reports
- Tense of the verbs - the best approach always is to use present tense
